#### Please note:

- 1. All Tuition Fees are calculated on an annual basis.
- 2. Each academic year has three terms. Fees are payable by arrangement either annually or termly, before the due date, ideally, before the commencement of the term.
- 3. The fees include all notebooks and stationery.
- 4. Residential and International school trips will be charged separately and must be paid in full before the trip.
- 5. Examination entry fees are charged separately and will be communicated to you at appropriate times.
- 6. Pre-primary applicants are only exempted from the capital development fund upon enrolment. The amount remains in the student's account and is expected to be paid upon entry into primary school.
- 7. The total fee for the initial enrolment in the first year at CIS is worked out using the relevant figures from the above tables as follows: Assessment Fee + Registration Fee + Maintenance Fee + Relevant termly Tuition Fee (and Boarding Fees for students enrolled in boarding)

#### CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION

- 1. Half the fees are payable by the end of the preceding term, and the balance is due at the start. All fees must be paid by the first day of each term.
- 2. Students will not be admitted to class unless school fees have been paid.
- 3. Development and school fees should be paid upon admission and, after that, annually.
- 4. The principal reserves the right to exclude from school students whose fees are unpaid at the beginning of the term.
- 5. Any examination fees should be paid before the examination to confirm entry into exams.
- 6. All cash or cheque payments must be made through the school's Accounts Office. Cheques should be payable to "Covenant International School".
- 7. Cheques returned by the bank will incur a handling charge of 10% at face value and must be replaced by a bank-certified cheque or cash.
- 8. If Payment is made by bank transfer, please advise the Accounts Office of details to facilitate receipt issuance.
- 9. We are pleased to advise that a 5% discount is offered on a year's fees paid in advance (tuition fees only). This must be settled before the close of the term prior to entry.
- 10. Sibling discounts. The eldest pays in full, and the second child and subsequent children receive a 5% discount on tuition only.
- 11. Overdue balances will attract interest of 5% per month (compounded), which will be added to the outstanding due balance.
- 12. The students shall follow all school rules and regulations as laid down in the prospectus and occasionally communicate them to students and parents. See student **handbook**.
- 13. A term's written notice is required for your child to withdraw from Covenant International School or a term's school fees in full.
- 14. On leaving the school, the student must complete a clearance form, which the school authorities should sign.
- 15. Parents should come to school to discuss their children's progress when required.
- 16. Parents will support the school in cases of disciplinary action against their child.
- 17. I have read the student code of conduct/student handbook and agree that my child will follow it in full and any amendments made from time to time by the school authorities.
